Dr Ranko Rajović - *Ponašanje učenika, gubitak motivacije za učenje*

Današnji učenici su odrasli u doba brzog razvoja informacione tehnologije i digitalnih medija. Tehnološka pismenost može biti od koristi u nastavnom procesu, ali takođe može stvoriti izazove u održavanju pažnje i koncentracije tokom časova. Russell Stannard - *Integrating AI in our teaching and learning*

In this highly practical talk, Russell will focus on some of the key AI tools emerging into the market and will show how these tools can be integrated into our teaching and learning. The focus will be on both inside and outside the class. Russell will present ideas that will save preparation time, help with creative uses of coursebooks, and focus on how we can help students absorb AI into their homework and autonomous studies. If you are looking to learn what AI can do and want tips and tricks you can immediately take into class, then this is the talk for you.

The focus is on free, easy to use tools that you can easily introduce into your teaching and learning that can really have an impact on our teaching and learning.

Grzegorz Śpiewak, Ph.D. - *To test or NOT to test? Smart assessment in your language classroom*

Any language teacher knows that students, particularly teenagers, hate traditional tests. And that testing has come under massive attack in recent years, especially in the times of forced on-line teaching. This said, we also know that a typical learner does want to know whether s/he is making any progress. So, the answer really isn't: let's abandon all testing but rather: let's try to be a lot smarter about how we test, and how we assess overall. This is where this super practical session comes in. I'll offer a number of alternatives to traditional testing methods, all tried and tested with numerous students. You'll see for yourself that such alternatives are NOT time-consuming or difficult to prepare – in fact, they can make your workload quite a bit lighter ...? intrigued? Come along to find out, and to sample them all, plus some tricks and assessment lifehacks.
